THE GENERAL STORE, 2683 Charlestown Road
Established in the 18th century in the hamlet then called Handsrabble, the store also served both as a tavern and a post office at various times in its history. This old picture was taken in the 1870s when the first John Peirce was its owner. In the 1890s it was acquired by Katie Baughman whose daughter, Kathryn Allender, carried on the business until 1953 when suburban traffic and lack of parking forced its closing. It is now privately owned.
